Wednesday, March 1st - Thursday, March 2nd

Arrival to Quito

Hello, family & friends! We are super excited about the itinerary we have prepared from beginning to end so read carefully and if you have any questions please don't hesitate to contact us.

General Information

We strongly suggest that you arrive on Wednesday, March $1^{\rm st}$ if you think that your body might need more rest considering the altitude. Usually, it takes around three days for your body to adapt to the altitude. If you want to take fewer days to rest and begin the adventure as soon as possible, then travelling on Thursday, March $2^{\rm nd}$ is also ok, but bear in mind that your body will be going through an adapting process while in the activities.

Lodging

Despite the wedding ceremony and reception will be in Quito, the capital of Ecuador, we highly encourage foreign guests to stay in Puembo on Wednesday and Thursday night. Puembo is a small village between Quito and the airport, which is located about 30 minutes from the capital.

We have negotiated rates at <u>Hostería Rincon de Puembo¹</u>. They have agreed to grant our guests 2016 rates, but we encourage you to make your reservations soon.

Friday, March 3rd – Sunday, March 5th

Journey to the Tropical Andes in Mindo

General Information

Mindo is a small village set in the cloud-forest with plenty of "American Friendly" resorts. Its diverse wildlife attracts birdwatchers, but also other tourists looking for outdoor adventures. Mindo is located about two hours away from Quito.

Travel and schedule

We will travel to Mindo as a group, and plan to leave the Hostería Rincon de Puembo via shuttle at 10 AM. On the way we will stop by "El Crater de Pululahua" for lunch, and should arrive in to the hotel in Mindo in the late afternoon where we can enjoy dinner and game night with other guests.

On Saturday there will be a number of options for your exploring pleasure. Activities you could sign-up for in Mindo include: Canopy adventures, hiking, bird and butterfly watching, chocolate tours, waterfall and zip lining tours.

Lodging

We have made arrangements with a local hotel, the Terrabambu Lodge² for the two nights (Friday and Saturday) in Mindo. On sunday evening, we will head back to the Hostería Rincon de Puembo¹ where we will sleep as well.

Dress Code

Wear comfortable clothes and shoes for hikes and outdoor activities. Sometimes there are many mosquitos in the area, so try covering your arms and legs. Also, bring your bathing suit, as the hotel has a pool with a great view of the local area.

Journey to Otavalo & Lago San Pablo

General Information

The Otavalo cultural tour is a wonderful way to discover and combine the famous artesian indigenous market in Ecuador and some of the amazing views outside Otavalo. Otavalo is located in the northern Andean Region, two hours away from Quito.

Travel and Schedule

The tour begins with a scenic drive north of Quito through the Sierra highlands.

Our first stop will be Cayambe, where we can taste and learn about the town's famous bizcochos (local biscuits). From that point we will continue to the famous market of Otavalo, where you'll have the option to purchase local handicrafts. Our professional guide will provide an explanation on the indigenous people of this area, such as the Quitu, Cara and other pre-Inca groups, and some information on the city.

Afterwards, we'll have lunch, and then we'll go to the beautiful Laguna Cuicocha, which is located in a volcano crater and contains 2 green islands. Just before going back to Quito, we'll pass through the viewpoint of Lago San Pablo, to finish a perfect day. The visit of a work shop of musical instruments of wood is optional, depending on your wish and the time we spend on the market.

We will head back to Hostería Rincon de Puembo¹.

Papallacta Hot Springs & Spa

General Information

An hour and fifteen-minute drive east of Quito through a section of the Andean Highlands - Papallacta Hot Springs & Spa is a place of outdoor pools brimming with natural thermal waters beneath green volcanic peaks and towering snow-capped Antisana volcano. This place may just be one of the best hot springs / spas in South America.

Papallacta's gardens could easily stand as an attraction on their own, but landscaped around a seemingly endless network of outdoor thermal pools, intimately interlaced with the hotel's architecture, they result in an environment unlike any other when it comes to both awakening and soothing the senses. The first thing you will want to do is wander through the gardens and marvel at the seemingly endless supply pouring out of pottery earns into the pools. The grounds are extensive. There are pools in Papallacta's hotel section, the spa and public area of pools beside the spring's lively creek.

Travel and Schedule

We will travel as a group from the Hostería Rincon de Puembo, leaving shortly after breakfast (11 AM). The agenda in Papallacta is fairly loose, and up to you. Some may want to schedule a massage at the spa (see website for appointments: www.termaspapallacta.com), while others will want to explore the surrounding areas. One thing is for sure; you will want to bring your bathing suits, as the hot springs are incredible. We will have lunch in Papallacta and possibly enjoy a cocktail or two. As mentioned, the spa also offers massages, if you would like one, we would recommend making a reservation by contacting the Spa directly. The staff at the Papallacta spa speaks fluent English.

We will spend wednesday night in the <u>Termas de Papallacta</u>³.

Papallacta is located at an altitude even higher than Quito, please dress comfortably and warm (i.e. tennis shoes, jackets, etc.). Don't forget to pack your swimsuit to relax in the hot springs waters.
